are reading at and to find supplemental work for those students to utilize. Laurie Graebner requested \$2118.00 to renew 30 licenses for Learning A-Z and 10 licenses for RAZ Kid. Francisca Muniz motioned to provide the funding. Peg Barnett-Bruns seconded. Motion passed.
