- I. Call to Order - The meeting was called to order by Mrs. Bruns at 2:37 p.m.
- II. Minutes - The minutes from the last meeting (9/9/10) were read by Michelle Brown. Corrections were noted as follows: The SIP is due to Mr. Cline on Oct. 1, and Thinklink is no longer used this year, the Performance Matters program will replace it this year. A motion to approve the minutes with the corrections noted was made by Mr. Anderson and was seconded by Mrs. Dixon. The motion was approved.

New Business – Mr. Anderson explained the guideline for adding new members to the committee. SAC Parents must be approved by Boosters in order to serve on the committee. We then recognized new members to the SAC Committee. They are Bruce Collins (4<sup>th</sup> grade parent), Angela Ehling (Kdg Parent), Suzette Kiley (3<sup>rd</sup> grade parent), and Aida Schomburg (Migrant advocate/Parent Involvement Specialist)

Mrs. Bruns then asked for nomination for officer Elections. She explained that we would then vote on the 2010-2011 Mrs. Bruns asked for nominations for Chairperson. Peg Bruns was nominated to continue as chair for the second year. Bruce Anderson was nominated for Vice-Chair. Michelle Brown was nominated for Secretary and will provide the treasurer report as needed as well. All nominees were confirmed as officers with a unanimous vote.
