NOCATEE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL
September 9, 2010

- I. Call to Order - The meeting was called to order by Mrs. Bruns at 2:33 p.m.
- II. Minutes - The minutes from the last meeting (5/13/10) were read by Aida Schomburg. Mrs. Schomburg questioned the section regarding the compact statement as she was not in attendance for the May meeting. A motion to approve the minutes with the compact section omitted was made by Mr. Anderson and was seconded by Mrs. Bruns. The motion was approved.
- III. New Business – Mr. Anderson explained the SAC will meet once per month on the 2nd Thursday. However, he requested a second meeting on September 30, in order to have time to complete the School Improvement Plan and have this plan approved before it is due to Superintendent Cline on September 31st.

Mr. Anderson also explained the School Advisory Council (SAC) is the steering committee for our school and the committee will vote on the 2010-2011 officers at the September 30th meeting. Mrs. Bruns asked for nominations for President, Vice-President, Secretary and possibly Treasurer.

Mrs. Aida Schomburg introduced both herself and Lisa Norris as the Parent Involvement Specialists. She also explained the Parent/Teacher Compact.

Mr. Anderson commented that the school dress code was a huge success. Our students look wonderful and he has received many positive comments from teachers and parents.
- IV. 21st Century Program - Mrs. Denison is the 21st Century Director. She explained this is an after school enrichment activity on Monday through Thursday for 3rd through 5th grade.
- V. Role of the School Advisory Council – Mr. Anderson explained SAC has specific guidelines designed by the state. The most important goal of SAC is to increase student achievement in a safe environment. SAC is open to the public but only committee members are allowed to vote.
- VI. Ms. Graebner presented data and scores from last year. She explained our school grade and the different subgroups involved in computing the grade. FCAT, FAIR, and Thinklink are some of the tests used to find out a student's academic growth. Ms. Graebner also shared a breakdown of last year's discipline data.

- VII. Professional Development – Mr. Anderson said Sue D’Angelo will be here for two days in September to provide professional development on number sense.
- VIII. Respect Theme – The theme for Nocatee this year is RESPECT. Mrs. Denison worked with a student committee last year and will continue to do so this year. Each class made a respect poster this year and the posters were hung around the school. This theme includes the whole school.
- IX. Mrs. Bruns thanked everyone for attending the meeting and asked those present to consider becoming a member or an officer of SAC. She asked all to attend the September 30th meeting.

Mr. Anderson made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Mrs. Muniz seconded and the meeting was adjourned.
