I. Start time/Horacio de Empezar:

II. Welcome/Bienvenidos:

IV. Unfinished business/Asuntos incompletos:

A) A budget request for \$1600.00 was approved for the purchase of DRA kits for grades K-3. Instructional Services through the county office has agreed to purchase 4 kits for NES/therefore SAC will not be expending those monies. The Kits have arrived and have been distributed and are being put to use.

Mrs. Jackson questions as to why there were 4 DRA kits instead of the 5 SAC had originally approved. Mr. Anderson stated that since funding had become available through Instructional Services, the school felt that they could accomplish their goals with the 4 kits that were provided. We had decided not to purchase the 5<sup>th</sup> kit.

V. New Business/Asuntos Nuevos:

A) Additional equipment for playground

Tether balls and soccer goals to create a regulation field have arrived and are going to be installed soon. The soccer field will be incorporated into the physical education classes as soon as it is completed.

B) FCAT now in progress for grades 3-5. The testing window is March 9-19  
FCAT is now in progress for grades 3-5. The testing seems to be going smoothly.

C) School uniforms

Mr. Anderson stated that the school has been asked by the District to survey parents to see if they would be interested in going to a District wide uniform for next year. The District is in favor of a school uniform policy. They feel that it will be cost effective for parents and result in a lack of competition in regards to clothing of students. No choices have been finalized. The survey will determine the options. Color choices will probably be gender neutral. Locally, when DMS went to uniforms this past year, vendors in the area offered the shirts at reasonable prices. One parent suggested the possibility of assigned colors for certain days. Mr. Johnson suggested that staff and administration be included on the survey regarding uniform requirements.

VI. SIP/Title I/21<sup>st</sup> Century: update by Mr. Anderson;

A) Revised Student Progression Plan

Laurie Graebner provided an update on the student progression plan. They are available on the website for review.

## B) Revised K-12 Reading Plan

Florida State Required an updated reading plan for the 2010-2011 year. Plan is now in progress. They are always open to suggestions or idea for improvement. Updates are available on the website.

Mr. Johnson questioned that rumors were circulating regarding the elimination of FCAT. Bruce Anderson stated that they will not be eliminating the test. Laurie Graebner stated that they are revising the test.
