- I. Start Time/Horario de Empezar: 2:30PM
Call to order/Empezar la junta
- II. Welcome/Bienvenidos:
Peg Bruns called the meeting to order at 2:30 PM and welcomed everyone present. Sign in sheets were passed around and signed.
- III. Minutes Read & Approved/Minutos Aprobado:

- IV. Unfinished Business/Asuntos Incompletos:
Additional equipment for playground

 - b. School uniforms - survey update

Students in Laps 5, 6, & 7 will receive medals. Boosters will pay for stickers. Prizes were also included in the requested funds above.
